Chats With Carlos



This is an open letter to the membership from the incoming Diablo President. For those of you don't know me, Carlos Bocanegra, I'm a 10-year member of PCA and the Diablo Region and I have been elected by the incoming board to be President for 2017.

I am the current active Tour Chair. In the past, I have been a Drivers' Education chair as well as I have also volunteered for various events and tours. I do not have an activity that I would say is my favorite PCA activity. I have been an active Driver Education participant since 2007. I have tried autocross, tours, rallies,

Parade and Escape (Treffen). I find that I pretty much, along with my wife, attend all types of events: Awards Banquet, Picnic and Wash N Shine (Car Show); so much, that my family has grown to a 2 car Porsche family ('09 C4S and my series of Boxsters with a 2014-S as the current model). I have gained some PCA recognition as I'm serving on the National Tour Committee that is almost complete with a set of Policy and Procedures for Touring. For one reason or another, I've been attending Board meetings over the past 6 years. I have also been initiated to the PCA way by long standing members Ted and Ingrid French.

I'm know to be outspoken, but don't let that deter you from reaching out to me – I value inclusion. Speaking of inclusion, this is an asset from our outgoing president Ed Won that I value very much.

A couple of trivia items about me: I am foreign born, a US citizen and I have lived my entire life in the USA. I lived as a pre-teen in the neighborhood that was used for the movie Dog Day Afternoon. I've been known to yell, "Attica, Attica..." I also worked for a renowned archaeologist in Central America for 2 years. The most fun was dirt bike riding through the streets of a Mayan City and I did find out that in high humidity wounds take longer to heal. I have lived the greater part of my life in California, the last 15 in the Bay Area and previously in Orange County and LA County. I currently work as a project manager for a large utility.

Diablo is inclusionary and not exclusionary with 859-plus primary members and 448-plus affiliate members and, I want to add, growing! Just a note, interaction between existing Diablo members and new members should be considered a two-way street. We have members, for example, who only do Driver Education days and others just do breakfast.

Even though we have 1,300-plus members, there is an association of 50 or more of what I call the 'usual suspects' that create all of the activities that are open to you. You might suspect here that I really like Casa Blanca the movie. That said, a new face isn't often recognized, so just say, "hello" and we can begin the conversation of a lifetime. I find it wonderful to meet new people or members that are just now coming out.

Porsche cars! I've become a mid-engine enthusiast over these past 10 years. Outside of Porsche race cars, the Boxster won me over when it first came out. I can't think of any other automobile that has such a rich history and that at the end of the day, proves to be utilitarian in every sense of the word that gratifies you with a huge smile as an owner. In 10 years, Diablo has changed where the older cars are regulated to short runs and mostly concours and the growth has come from members with newer cars. 






MAMMOTH / JOINT TOUR


