The Club (Region) is incorporated with the State of California as a non-profit organization in accordance with the California Corporations Code. We have a five member Board. Directors' terms are two years and are staggered with three Directors being elected in even numbered years and two Directors elected in the odd numbered years. Director terms commence January 1<sup>st</sup> in the year following their election.

The Board is responsible for the proper conduct of the administrative affairs of the Diablo Region, the proper functioning of the committees, and compliance with the bylaws of the Club. Each year, the board elects from among themselves the positions of President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Director at Large. Board meetings are held monthly on the second Monday of the month, typically from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM.
