

The Porsche Boxster and Boxster S were selected Best Sports Car by the editors of *Automobile Magazine* in the publication's 2004 All-Stars award competition.

It marks the third time the monthly automotive enthusiast publication has selected the Boxster for its annual All-Star Award. Previously, the Boxster also won Automobile Magazine 's prestigious Automobile of the Year award.

Between them, the 2.7 liter, 225 horsepower Porsche Boxster and 3.2 liter, 258 horsepower Boxster S have also tallied five-straight 10 Best Awards from *Car and Driver* magazine.

When the green flag dropped for the 42nd running of the Rolex 24 Hours at Daytona, a record128 Porsche drivers were on hand to participate in 28 Porsche 911-based race cars and three Porsche-powered Daytona prototypes.

"This was one of the largest turnouts of Porsche race cars ever at an internationallysanctioned race," said Uwe Brettel who has replaced Alwin Springer as the president of Porsche Motorsport North America. With 56 cars entered in the race, Porsches made up more than half the field.

From the Editor

If you look closely the photo you will see George, the exceptional Claridge sales professional, as he delivered my new 2002



Boxster S to me. Next you may recall the dilema that I attempted confront the tension between being loyal to a dealership where you car was purchased and other options for service from shops or dealerships that support this newsletter through advertising.

For my 45,000 service, I chose the Sonnen dealership. The selection was based on more than one reason but included their easily being the advertiser who contributes the largest sum toward sponsorship of this newsletter.

I feel good about the serv ice experience mostly because of the individual and immediate attention from both a mechanic and the Service Advisor. For example, some of you on recent tours will recall that my Boxster had developed an automatic signal for whenever I got down to zero mph by popping the rear deck lid. Expecting a complicated electronic fix, I was nearly speachless as the mechanic fixed it within about five seconds after hearing me list it as a problem.

The attention was immediate since I was not in a line with other makes sold by the same dealership. I also liked that that the "S" was put on the hoist as part of the intake process. The Advisor and I looked at all sorts of stuff that I had previously never seen on my Porsche. At my 15,000 service, the Boxster was taken by a non mechanic employee to and from the inner bowels of the dealership and I had no contact with a mechanic or look at my car other than from an ouside doorway.

Serveral of us from Diablo had previously been invited to racing related

special activities at Sonnen and I had become acquainted with one of their mechanics with extensive experience with European Porsche race teams (the same one who fixed my popping rear deck lid in five seconds). I enjoyed the opportunity to discus suspension and other setup, e.g., relationship of tire and wheels sizes, issues as part of the overall service experience.

During this same time period, our then President elect experienced a serious (when shops and dealers quotes are four figures it is clearly serious) transmission problem with his Carrera giving us look at service and repair issues from an other than new car angle.

One dealer proposed leaving the Carrera for an inspection followed by a time period waiting for parts. Denny Kahler's proposal had no such long wait for parts and no separate all-day appointment for the inspection. Interestingly, Denny mostly gets his Porsche parts from Sonnen suggesting that both of these options may have faster availability of parts than the dealer with the long wait. The estimated and actual costs at Kahler's was lower than the numbers proposed by the dealer mentioned above.

One nice aspect of my most recent Sonnen service, a warranty replacement of the windshield trim, was that the no cost loaner was a '04 Boxster.

Classes: Everyone is in the same class. Permissible equipment includes clipboard, paper, pens/pencils, highlighters, a watch or timing device, and a single-memory calculator. No rally charts or tables, calculators, or computers are permitted. Each rally car must have a driver and a navigator.

Preregistration: It is strongly recommended that entrants study the general rules prior to the event.
