

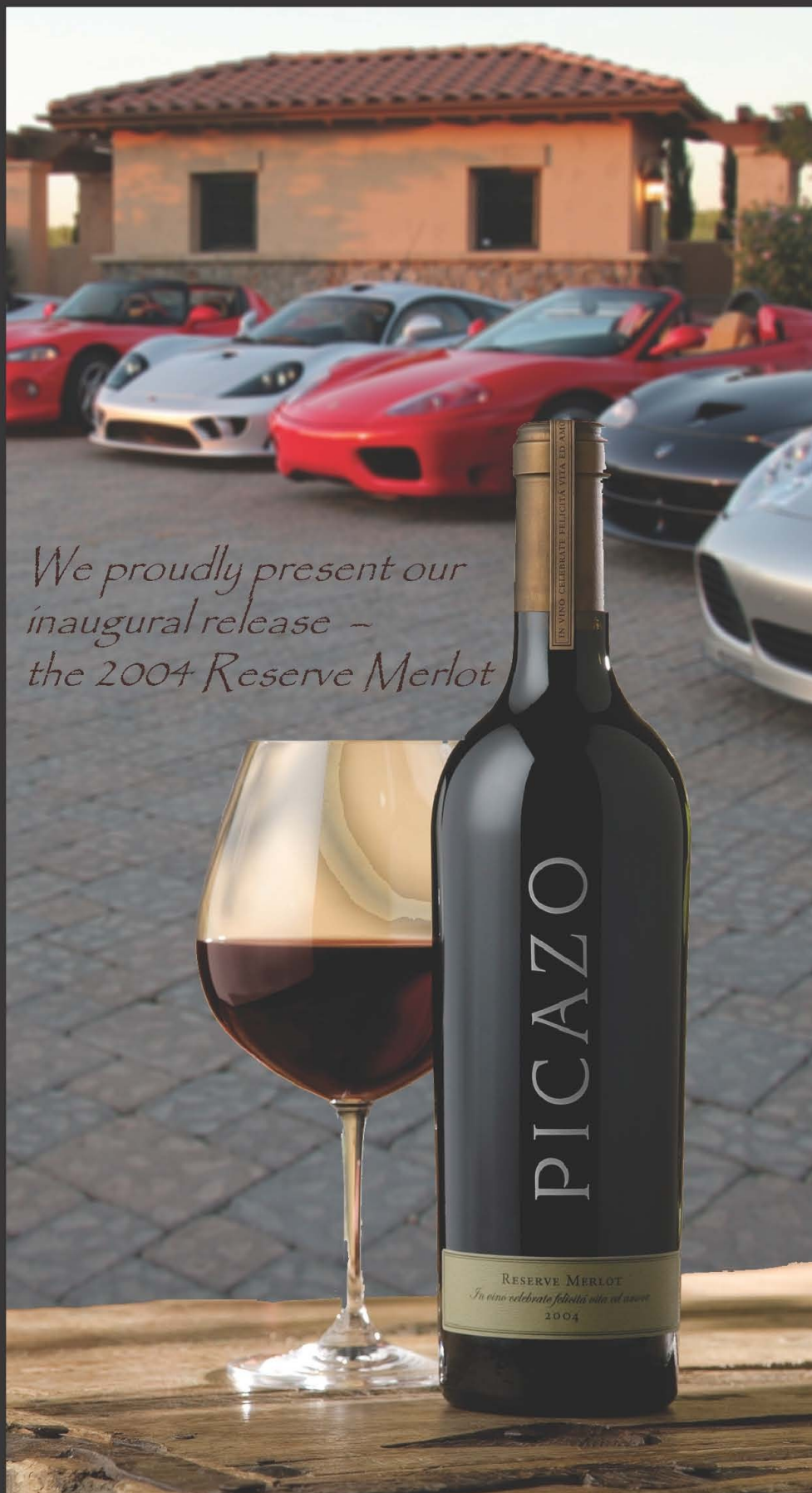

Advertiser Spotlight



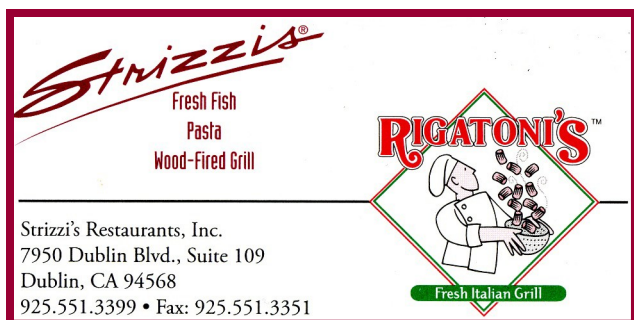
This month's advertiser in the spotlight is Strizzis Restaurants.

The Strizzi name has been associated with fresh Italian food for decades. In 1929, Luciano Strizzi and his wife Assunta, opened the L. Strizzi Italian Deli in Greensburg, PA.

Seventy years after that deli was opened, Ray Bartolomucci, their grandson, dedicated the opening of the first Strizzis restaurant in San Leandro to his grandparents. The Pleasanton restaurant debuted in 1989, Danville in 1992, Livermore in 1998 and Fremont in 2008.

Ray's background not only comes from old family recipes, his degree in Hotel and Restaurant Management as well as work experience with several major hospitality corporations, including Marriott Hotels, Steak & Ale Corporation and Restaurants Unlimited.

Strizzis restaurants is widely known throughout the San Francisco Bay Area for its fresh fish entrees and its fine Italian sauces and pasta preparations. Strizzis in Danville is the location for Diablo Region's monthly dinners.
