



Driving Tours are not usually the most memorable adventures in the life of a seven year old. The PCA Diablo Chapter's weekend Big Cats and Casino Tour dissolved this notion. The following recounts this Tour through the eyes and palates of seven year old twin girls seated in the back of a 1988 911 Targa.

The day began early on a Saturday with the alarm ringing sooner than even a school day would beckon. Bribes of syrup and powdered-sugar coated pancakes lured Ava and Bella (A&B) out of slumber and into the back of "Pint," a Black & Tan '88 Targa.

Upon reaching Buttercup Restaurant in Walnut Creek, the Pint tucked in among a row of beautiful Porsche Brethren. After the first bribe installment was



paid in the form of Pancakes and French Toast, our fearless leader, Lillie Echevarria, led the group to the parking lot to deliver the pre-Tour game plan. While the East Coast dug out of the latest winter snow storm, twenty gleaming Porsches from several evolutions of design, prepared to drive over 200 miles to Oroville, CA. For what? CA-160 offered up a stretch of scenic turns along the Sacramento Delta. The latter part of which allowed for some spirited throttle pops and suspension compressing turns. Our caravan of German

machinery looked to be more a scene from Bavaria than NorCal.

The first stop at Starbucks rewarded the group with a fresh cup of Joe and A&B the chance to top off their own tank with sweets. The top was lifted off the Targa and A&B constructed their well-rehearsed blanket cave in the backseat to withstand the anticipated windstorm.

The group navigated through another sixty miles of CA blacktop on I-5 and CA-70, arriving at the Barry Kirshner Wildlife Foundation (4995 Durham Pentz Rd, Oroville) for the much anticipated tour of their big cat facility. The tour did not disappoint, spotlighting the great appreciation, care and love the resident animals receive from their guardians.



According to A&B, the top prize went to the Liger who's lack of a growth control gene can propel their frame to over 1,200 lbs. Runners-up were Mr. Duck Duck, the sleeping and wrestling bears, ocelot, fox and jaguar.

With stomachs grumbling, we headed to Hof Brau to top off our own tanks. A variety of great sandwiches, soups and salads was punctuated, to the elation of A&B, with cookies the size of plates.

Stomachs on Full, we fired up our engines and headed up the twisty Oroville Dam Blvd to the Lake Oroville Visitor Center. We were treated to an enlightening but sobering presentation from the Dam docent (no disrespect intended) regarding the dire state Northern California's water reserve. We all left motivated and empowered with resources to initiate conservation measures in our homes and communities.



The Dam Tour continued with a stop at a scenic overlook to view the level of Lake Oroville and continue dialogue regarding this amazing engineering feat. The highlight, as seen through the mouths of

A&B, were the Cherry Candy Balls generously offered by a fellow driver.

With a personal escort, we paraded our German machines across the Dam for some Panorama Magazine worthy photos and another perspective on the Lake.



And where there's fresh mountain water there are fish so off we rolled to the Feather River Fish Hatchery. With the Cherry Balls wearing off and a 200 mile return trip still ahead, the "Pint" and A&B were loaded up for the hot shot back to the shadow of Mount Diablo. The

remainder of the group pushed on to the Feather Falls Casino to stable their Porsches and enjoy the evening.



An educational itinerary was met with stunning weather and punctuated with a great group of drivers and co-pilots. Special thanks to Lillie for organizing and coordinating this event. Until the next adventure, cheers and safe travels.


