

Advocating

ties and less able performances. Speaking of age, when I won the Boise Parade Autocross Boxster S class, the joy was just as much for doing it as a 67 year old as it was being a "National Champion."

The advantages of being aged come in loud and clear at an occasion such as the induction of the Zone 7 "Wall of Fame" members. Few people at the awards ceremony had the perspective that was mine. I clearly recall Bruce Anderson and Bob Garretson, for example, tearing up the Alameda County Fairgrounds parking lot with the stellar driving of their respective 356s. International driving titles and major wins and other achievments at Sebring, Daytona and Le Mans all have more impact when these big time events are connected back in time to local club beginnings.

I will never forget my first sight of all those kids tumbling out of the Neidel 356 at a GGR event. The family's contribution to all of Zone 7 is so extensive, so pervasive, and over such a long time period that their various "Family of Year" or whatever awards seem far too hollow or superficial to actually reflect the tangible contributions they have made in so many innumerable ways. I defy anyone to give some numerical value to the total that this family has given to PCA. I was fortunate to share the table with them about 25 years ago at the Reno Parade. At that time, the various family members had already given a lifetime worth of service to Porsche causes. On the 17th, Shirley was at it again by handing out handwritten e-mail addresses to people who had taken photos. She was concerned on behalf of those who were unable to attend, but who have the perspective of many years and who thus would enjoy knowing and seeing this Wall of Fame happening.

Go back to page 18 of the February Advocate and see the two bottles of wine that were my door prize. These were two of many, bearing his private label, donated by George Neidel that night.

Skipping around with other "Wall" inductee recollections, there was Milt Minter and his red 904 at Candlestick, his two "all 4 off" passes on consecutive laps at the Laguna corkscrew to beat Horst Owetch, and the Germany Region barbecue after he drove for Ted Fields at Le Mans.

Bud and Mary Ann Behrens and I go way back with commonalities such as autocrossers, being teachers and editing newsletters. When I joined GGR, Dwight Mitchell was the president and I vividly recall his SCCA championship that led to the Porsche/Audi 914 deal.

When it comes to John Clever, I will never forget how his huge beard and not too "trim and speedy" size collaborated, in the minds of the French press, with my even less "trim and speedy" size to be branded as the "gorillas" as we attempted crowd control at the '79 Le Mans race. The magnet that created the crowd problem was Paul Newman who was driving the red 935.


