


Doug's Corner

Fortunately, we passed the latest 'end of the world' day on December 21st without incident, so it means we can now think ahead to 2013...

We have track dates secured; Thunderhill on March 15th and Laguna Seca November 26th, as well as a second potential Thunderhill date on October 29th. It would be terrific if we could do these and more...to build on 2012 with our pre-event briefings, karting and other related activities to enhance the program.

Recently, we pulled together a group of members to discuss the feedback from our driver surveys, their experiences in 2012 and what Diablo DE strategy should be next year and beyond. We continue to see the nucleus of the DE program - the track events - as opportunities for Porsche drivers to experience safe, fast, fun.

We attract those who want the exhilaration of high performance driving and learning to do it better, with a bunch of like-minded people and with minimum risk to car or self.

Most frequent feedback we received from surveys was drivers want more instruction across the run groups.

The 'model' in 2012 was three run groups (Beginners, Intermediates & Advanced), with instructors running in the Advanced Group where we have relatively few drivers. With a maximum of 60 participants, ~20 drivers in each run group (at Laguna Seca we had 18 instructors), it is hard for instructors to help outside the Beginner Group as it means they would be working or driving 100% of the day! Many clubs use a 4 run group model, which means instructors have their own run group. However, this shortens track sessions for everyone and to an extent, loses the uniqueness of the Diablo experience...we will continue to strive for the right balance between track time and space on it!

In 2013 we are in the position of having a much stronger DE

program and participation than a year ago. So, our top priority is forming a larger 'core team' of organizer/volunteers to establish a Diablo DE committee who will communicate regularly and 'steward' the success of the program. Most importantly, who will take a share of the workload – it's not onerous, but the more help, the lighter the load!

Porsche Unveils 2013 Cayman in LA


Sports car maker Porsche was on hand at the 2012 Los Angeles Auto Show and took the opportunity to make the world premiere of the new 2013 Cayman. The 2013 Cayman represents the third-generation of the car and Porsche promises it's completely new. The 2013 model is lower, longer, lighter, and faster according to Porsche.



Porsche also promises that the new Cayman is also more efficient and more powerful than ever. Porsche says that the new Cayman is up to 30 kg lighter than the previous model <u>depending on</u> the specific version and how it's equipped. Porsche also notes that the new Cayman uses 15% less fuel per 100 km and the outgoing version of the Cayman.

Porsche stuck to the formula that has made the Cayman successful with the 2013 being a two-seat mid-engine sports car available as a standard Cayman and the more powerful Cayman S. The base Cayman uses a 2.7-liter flat six-cylinder engine producing 275 HP. The base Cayman is able to hit 100 KMH in 5.4 seconds with a top speed of 266 KMH.

The high-end Cayman S has a larger 3.4-liter flat-six engine producing 325 hp. This version is capable of reaching 100 KMH in 4.7 seconds when properly equipped and boasts a top <u>speed</u> of 283 KMH. The newly designed Cayman also has new optional features available for the first time including adaptive cruise control. Another first-time feature is an optional Burmester sound system. The Cayman also gets a new optional keyless Entry & Drive system. Pricing and availability is unknown at this time.
