

When you are checking out an event, be sure to look and see if it has a limit on the number of attendees. Many of our events this year have limited space for a variety of reasons. And, we expect many of them to sell out in advance. So, if you see one that interests you, don't wait too long to commit or you may be left out.

Our growth and the increase in our number of events has helped focus the board on membership communication improvements. We are in the process of updating/reconstructing the Diablo website. You probably already noticed some of the changes. Keeping our budget and volunteer time in perspective, the reconstruction will take several months. We expect the site to remain useable and show improvement on a regular basis. I want to thank Steve Jones, Ed Won, Kay Maloy and Walt Lietz for their input, ideas, and many hours put into making this better. It is a work in progress, so please be patient as we work through changes to make it more friendly and useful. We are aware that some members are not receiving the weekly email blasts and are working on a solution. We understand that this is an important news source for the Region. The board is also considering an online "Goodie Store" option and we hope to have an announcement soon. The plan is to give all Diablo members access to a number of different items from hats, shirts and jackets to coffee mugs etc. that have the Diablo Logo.

If you have been looking for a late model Porsche, and want to see all dealer's inventory, nationwide (or by distance from your zip code), check out the Porsche Pre-Owned Car Locator at www.porsche.com/usa/approvedused/usedcarlocator. I'm not sure if this site is common knowledge. USA Porsche Dealers list hundreds of cars there with

relatively accurate descriptions. You can even do a detailed search for only cars with features such as sports exhaust, sport seats, or PASM. It's easy to specify Certified Pre-Owned, if you so desire. I've been looking a little bit, but I need more time to really research my next Porsche. But it will probably come from this site.





DE Program Review

In lieu of Mike Roberts (DE Chair) submitting a column this month, the following information is to familiarize Diablo Region members with the specific elements of our DE Program that makes it unique and different from others.

- Monitor all driver sign up levels and follow-up personally with those drivers we don't know
- We only allow Porsches
- Appeal to relatively late model cars which are driven to/from the track
- Track Orientation/training
- A tech process, for which the driver is responsible
- A form, which is a legal disclaimer and a signed statement that driver complies with the 30 day rule
- 'Grid-Tech'
- We do Parade laps to orient drivers to the track and driving conditions
- Limited event size and run groups
- Relatively conservative Passing Rules and protocols
- Well-coordinated, experienced instructors monitor students, leaders monitor groups, CDI monitors instructors and group leaders

With advancing car technology, durability and performance, (stock) car component failures are a reducing cause of incidents at track days. Cars are faster than ever before, so increasing emphasis on training the driver is appropriate.

In addition to these elements, Diablo offers Track Introduction and Driver Preparation classes prior to the actual track event. The purpose is to get the members who are registered to drive at the scheduled event and those interested in getting more information about what the DE Program is, together with experienced drivers

and instructors to discuss:

- Safety Inspections—who is offering them
- Equipment for the track
- Attire
- What to expect upon arrival at the track
- What to expect during the day
- What each of the flags mean
- Driving tips and techniques
- Review of a video of the track that will be driven

There are many individuals who volunteer their time to make the track event and this additional presentation take place. If you are not interested in driving on the track, you can still get involved with the excitement and fun by volunteering to assist with the many tasks that take place at the track.
