



My Brumos Driving Experience

This was the Brumos Driving event I won through a charity raffle. It included a loaner Porsche from Brumos for the weekend.



I had a wonderful time at the Brumos Driving Experience in not so sunny Gainesville, Florida the beginning of February. The weather was about 50 degrees and the track was wet with a light



mist and occasional rain sessions. There were 18 P-Cars, of all ages, sizes and shapes participating.

The event was held at the Gainesville Raceway and I

was lucky enough to have the legendary Porsche endurance racer, Hurley Haywood, instructing my group, alternating with Andrew Davis from the Brumos GT3 racing team. To have such a storied racing champion drive my loaner Porsche from Bru-

mos, and then as a passenger, teach me a so many things while going around the track was incredible. He is soft spoken and a true gentleman. It's amazing how smooth his lines and throttle modulation are! Of course he has over 30 years of experience and his championship record speaks for itself.



Following some morning classroom discussions and breakfast, it was off to the track for the exercises. For the cones, figure 8's, braking and cornering exercises, we were instructed to turn off the traction and stability management. This really gives you a feel for how amazing these cars are, even with the PSM system turned off. A great catered lunch and feedback, Q&A on the morning exercises and then back to the track. Fortunately the weather cleared up enough where wipers were not needed for the

most part. For the final 3 exercises, which put together all the other exercises into two timed laps, we were allowed to turn on the traction and stability control systems. In order to complete the course, you had to safely, and I should say aggressively complete two laps of the course and they used your best time and the instructors were posted around the track to observe you.

After graduation, the finale was hot laps in the 1991 IMSA Supercar Champion 964 Porsche 911 Turbo SuperCar driven by



Hurley Haywood. I have been in some fast cars but I have never been in anything like this with a championship driver behind the wheel. Autocross

Autocross is a sport of trying to navigate your car through a defined course of pylons usually on a large parking lot, faster than your competition. Autocross courses are set up using soft orange traffic pylons which will not damage your car, but they <u>do</u> melt! Events are run at speeds usually between 40-65 MPH, usually in 2nd gear. Autocross is a *"performance driving event"* and a <u>safe</u> way to learn how to drive your car at its limit. You not only learn how to handle your car at speeds that you drive daily, but you also:

- Gain confidence in your driving ability
- Learn the limits of your car's brakes
- Learn correct seating, hand, and feet positions
- Learn the limits of your car's tire adhesion
