

#### Big Cats & Casino Tour

With the Cherry Balls wearing off and a 200 mile return trip still ahead, the "Pint" and A&B were loaded up for the hot shot back to the shadow of Mount Diablo. The remainder of the group pushed on to the Feather Falls Casino to stable their Porsches and enjoy the evening.


