




#### **Tri-Valley Saturday Breakfast**





Headquartered in Santa Rosa, CA, Canine Companions is the largest non-profit provider of assistance dogs, and is recognized worldwide for the excellence of its dogs, and the quality and longevity of the matches it makes between dogs and people. The result is a life full of increased independence and loving companionship.

Canine Companions was founded in Santa Rosa, CA in 1975. Both the National Headquarters and Northwest Regional Center are located on the Jean and Charles Schulz Campus in Santa Rosa, California. The Northwest Region covers Northern California, Northern Nevada, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana, Alaska, and Wyoming.

Canine Companions uses Golden Retrievers, Labrador Retrievers, and crosses of these two breeds. Most of our dogs come from Canine Companions selective breeding program. Occasionally, donated puppies are accepted if they meet the strict qualification requirements.


