A Special Golden Gate/Diablo Region Combined Event

Summary: This Driver's Education (DE) event will be a noncompetitive single day outing at Thunderhill racetrack, run under PCA National Drivers Education Guidelines expressly for PCA members. (Note: Although Friday is specifically set-aside for this special GGR/Diablo DE, the ensuing Saturday and Sunday are a part of the regular GGR Driver's Education/Time Trial Series.

The objective of the event is to provide the opportunity for Porsche Club members, especially those having little or no track experience, to safely learn the techniques of driving a high speed road course while operating under expert supervision and instruction. Only Porsche cars will be permitted on track for this event. <u>Special Note for Novices: "Ground School" or rather</u> the PCA requisite pre-event safety and procedures briefing will be provided at the track the morning of the event and no prior classroom activity will be necessary before attending this track day. Novices attending Friday's DE will have met the "Ground School" requirement for DE for Saturday and Sunday, should they choose to also attend those days (at additional cost, of course).

The Admission Fee per driver will be \$195 for those who register and pay before February 21. After that, the registration fee will increase to \$230. Lunch is not included in the fee for the day's event, but will be available. The Admission Fee for Event Instructors will be \$160. Featuring: This DE event comprises traditional Novice, Intermediate, and Advanced Run Groups. All Novice Drivers will be paired with an Event Instructor/s until the Novice has demonstrated the skill sets necessary for solo track driving. In accordance with PCA Guidelines, "the car owner must certify that their car is safe to run on the track and that the car has been inspected by a regionally approved person or shop within thirty days prior to the event. A regionally approved person need not be in the business of commercially preparing cars, but must have recognized skill in the preparation of cars that he/she inspects."
