
We received the following email Thank You from Shepherd's Gate:





### Tour da Jour 2009

Being a navy brat in my early years, this brought back fond memories, going on base again. I was impressed that the tour only required us to be on the freeway for a short 2 miles, before getting off and traveling the back roads the rest of the tour! Another great impression was the leader made very sure all the cars stayed together and no one got lost. Everyone used the "watch the person behind you" rule and with that, everyone stayed together.

We did have to cut some of the route short due to time, as it took us longer than we thought so to get back on schedule, some of the route was scratched. This then brought us on time for the scheduled lunch at the Cypress Lakes Golf Course. After our lunch, we headed for the base not far away. Jack Carpenter arranged for clearance for us, and it was an easy check at the gate and then on to the Museum.

The museum had many of the aircraft outside and some inside as well. The one that caught my immediate attention was the Hugh aircraft right outside the museum......the Douglas C124 C—Globemaster II. They referred to this one as "Old Shakey". It featured clamshell loading doors and an elevator under the aft fuselage. It was capable of hauling bulky cargo, & 200 fully equipped soldiers! Its weight is 216,000 lbs! It required the 'long' runway to get up.

The museum had many interesting articles, many from Dec 7, 1942 when we were invaded by the Japanese. It was so interesting to read these old papers. There was an old retired Air Force gentleman that gave us a tour. He was a pilot long ago and interesting to listen to.


