

### SEVENTY-ONE YEARS BEHIND THE WHEEL

### **Le Mans 1995**

The first 24 hours of Le Mans in 1923 was won by Chenard and Walker, two Frenchmen.

They averaged 57.205 mph and covered 1372.939 miles. In 1971, Porsche set the highest speed of any race to date when Helmut Marko and Gijs Lennep, in a 917, covered 3319.205 miles, averaging 138.133 mph. How many years did this major achievement take for Porsche?

The first Porsche raced at Le Mans in 1951 when a Model 1100 (1100cc's) was entered by Porsche's first French Dealer, Augestue Veuillet, a well known French racing figure. His enthusiasm for the new car was so great that he met with Pro-lessor Porsche and convinced him that a good showing at Le Mans would give Porsche world wide recognition. Veuillet and his co-driver Mosche entered their lone Porsche, won their class and Porsche gained international recognition.

Porsche went on to many class wins in succeeding years, but their first outright win was in 1970, when Hans Herrman and Richard Attwood won the race in a Short Tail 917. Since 1970 Porsche has been the overall winner 12 times with the latest being last year.

1995 kept the Porsche supporters hopeful until the end of the race when the Porsche powered Courage C34, (see photo) driven by Mario Andretti, Bob Rollick and Eric Hilary came in second overall. Early in the race, with Mario driving and a very wet track, the C34 hit a barrier wall. The rear wing was damaged so badly, it had to be removed and replaced. Unknown to the spectators and the competition a spare wing had been flown into the small airfield adjacent to the course just minutes before the accident. Half an hour later, the C34 was back in the action and challenged the leaders with better and better lap times. Unfortunately for Porsche and all other makes, this was to be the first big win for Mc Laren at Le Mans and they finished 1st, 3rd, 4th and 5th. With Porsche accounting for 13 of the starting cars, it was hard to accept that only 5 finished the

One activity for Porsche club members at the Sarthe, was a real winner, and that was the big Porsche party in the Tribune Campground next to the Dunlap Bridge. A Texas style Bar-B-Q was organized by Margaret Holz of the Germany Region with help from the British Porsche Club. Along with a dozen other travelers from the U.S.A., Jan and I were welcomed like long lost relatives from home. I must mention that a large percentage of the PCA Germany members are U.S. military. What a great evening, super food, mild weather, fellowship,

French Wine, German Beer and even pre-ordered T Shirts to mark the occasion. (see photos). After being in Europe for over six weeks it was also nice to enjoy the camaraderie of so many people without worrying about our French or German vocabulary. While most of the Porsche fans were in tents and RV's, we just barely managed to survive in our Hertz Spanish Seat Sedan. After the party the weather got very wet and cold and our quarters were far below French 1 Star accommodations. Our rental was new and clean but not very comfortable. I must say that Jan had every reason to complain, but she was a good sport about our situation.

Possibly our biggest surprise was although we had wonderful meals on this and other trips to France, the food in our area of the course was far from good. Food could be found almost everywhere, but it amounted to what you find at a bad carnival.
