

Owning a sports car is a wonderful thing. Being able to use the designed-in capabilities is even better. Porsche's racing history is focused on developing high performance automobiles. The technology built into the cars far exceeds what can be exercised on public streets. I have wanted the chance to get on a closed course to understand and learn how to use my Boxster.




Here we are at dinner the night before where preregistration and greeting each other was done for those who came down early.

As a new person to track days I didn't know what to expect. The club does a great job of getting information out and helping with the integration of new attendees. Drivers' Education covers many aspects of driving skills; methods for reading the line on a track, (braking, turn in, apex, and tracking out). All was very useful to hear and very different to actually experience in real life.





Safety and organization is priority 1, right along with having fun.

Having safety inspections already completed at shops makes it easy to know the cars are safe for the event.



The forms are double checked, helmets inspected for proper safety certification, and all loose articles removed from the vehicle.

One of the important skills we learned was safe passing with a "**Point By**" for each car.

What did I find? The instructors were great. The Diablo program gives as much information as I needed for a safe track session. The program information also gave me content to reflect on and desire to improve & learn more.

Did I drive the line? Only a couple times, but at least I was recognizing when I didn't. As such in the later sessions, I decided to fight my emotions and focus on the new driving skills; reading the course, driving the line, implementing the advice from my instructor. The instruction I received added to my driving capability making me aware of better ways to drive as well as capabilities of my Porsche. Does this aid in daily driving? Well yes. My steering has smoothed out and anticipation of conditions ahead has improved.

With 4 groups of 25 cars sharing the track there needs to be a lot of coordination for the event to operate. I observed (and overheard comments on) how well run the sessions were.

In addition to the time on the track, instruction, good friendship, we had very nice raffle prizes, lunch, & on track photos taken. My thanks and praise goes out to the sponsors, Walnut Creek Porsche, Kahler's, partners from Hooked on Driving and all the other volunteers involved for this event.




